Indianapolis hosted the 2022 college football national championship game, drawing thousands of out-of-state visitors. Johnson County is the contiguous southern Indy suburb and major player in the Indy economic corridor. Aspire was presented with an advertising opportunity within the official championship game program.

The championship game attendee demographics aligned very well with those of the company executives that make company expansion decisions, as well as the type of talent we seek to attract to live / work in our community. Moreover, the program distribution plan included pre-game distribution on the campuses and cities of the participating teams. No Indiana team was likely bound for the championship game, meaning our business attraction message would be in front of new audiences.

We took advantage of the ad opportunity, and then applied the creative to create a marketing campaign to market our community to company site selectors and market Aspire to prospective members.

Campaign Objectives:

Campaign Strategies:

1. The Program Ad - We directed our marketing agency partner, Hirons, to design a full-page ad that projected our brand voice: confident, welcoming, hardworking, energetic, and fresh. We wanted swagger!

- 2. The "Slanting the Playing Field in your Direction" Marketing Campaign Aspire's graphic designer and webmaster then utilized the elements of the primary ad to create a broader marketing campaign for two buckets of audiences.
 - a. Site selectors/commercial brokers, high-value talent, and local business leaders (to inspire local pride and excitement). We used the primary ad message and elements to create:
 - 6x11 postcard we mailed to 100 site selectors/commercial real estate brokers (attached)
 - 22x28 signboard we displayed at select events Q1 2022, in our office lobby this YTD, and in the front window at our county's tourism office for the month of January.
 - Masthead for Aspire's home page this YTD (attached)
 - Social media posts
 - b. *Prospective and current members.* We modified the bullet points on how we are "slanting the playing field" to speak about member services. We created:
 - 6x11 postcard we mailed to 150 prospective members (attached)
 - Full page ad within our legislative series event program (six-events)
 - Full page ad within our member resource handbook
 - Full page ad within the local B2B news magazine.
 - 22x28 signboard to display at monthly chamber events Q1 2022
 - E-news content partition ad in all emails Q1 2022

Aspire's website traffic improved during the first two months of 2022 compared to the same period in 2021: users were up 31%; new users were up 33%; and sessions were up 30%. The campaign generated positive feedback, local business leader pride and excitement, and a little extra swagger in the staff team's step.
